WHAT IS DEFERRED ACTION FOR CHILDHOOD ARRIVALS (DACA)?

DACA provides a two-year, renewable work permit and exemption from deportation for eligible young people who arrived in the U.S. before age 16 and have lived here continuously since June 2007.

If you are applying for the first time, please contact an immigration attorney to discuss whether this is the best option for you.

DACA RENEWAL

If you are renewing your DACA status, you must:



Submit your DACA renewal request between **150** days and **120** days before the expiration date located on your current DACA approval notice.



Complete 3 forms (\$495 fee including \$380 application fee and \$85 biometrics fee).

- 1) The most recent version of Form I-821D, Consideration of Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals
- 2) Form I-765, Application for Employment Authorization
- 3) Form I-765W Worksheet

Do not send additional documents except new documents relevant to removal proceedings or criminal history that you have not submitted previously.

Once forms are received, you will be sent an appointment notice for your biometrics screening at an Applicant Support Center. You must submit new biometrics as part of your renewal.

- A) Apply and receive DACA.
- B) Use DACA to complete FASFA.
- C) Access to Student Aid Report (SAR).
- D) SAR leads to institutional aid and other scholarships.

Some scholarships will consider DACA applicants, even if they advertise for citizens. **Ask!**
